

APPLICATION TO STUDY A VCE/VET SUBJECT IN YEAR 10

Information

VCE subjects are elective modules in Year 10. In order to **satisfactorily complete** a VCE subject, students **must complete all of the required tasks and submit them by the due date**. Therefore any student wishing to complete a VCE or VET subject in Year 10 must be able to demonstrate the following:

- High level of attendance
- Dedicated approach to completing work in and out of school
- Strong organisational and time management skills
- A very good record of completing work by the due date

Students **MUST** have a recommendation from their Year 9 teacher of this, or a similar subject, endorsing their subject selection.

The College offers a range of VCE and VET subjects for students to select. Students may only select **one VET or VCE** subject. The VCE subjects are:
